



To all patrons of Batesons Martial Arts and Northwest Jiu Jitsu. The following outlines the, required temporary guidelines in the operation of our facility. These guidelines are in place to ensure the highest level of safety to minimize the risk of COVID- 19. They are in accordance to the guidelines outlined by workers compensation board (WorkSafe BC). We ask that all patrons follow and respect these guidelines.

- 1.) If you or any member of your household have any of the following symptoms you will not be permitted into the facility and we would ask that you stay home. Fever, Chills, Cough, Sore Throat.
- 2.) Sanitize your hands upon entering the facility. You can sanitize your hands also between use of any equipment.
- 3.) Please wear flip flops to the school and place them on the shoe rack located at the entrance of the facility.
- 4.) Please come to the school in your uniform, there will be no access to change rooms.
- 5.) Please do not bring any equipment. All equipment will be provided here at the school and the instructors will sanitize it.
- 6.) The school has been set up to maintain two meters (minimum) social distancing. Please follow directions to allocated locations on the floor and please stay in your allocated area.
- 7.) There are 15 minute breaks between classes. This is to allow time for students to leave the school, instructors to sanitize the school and bring in the next class of students.
- 8.) Please arrive 5 minutes before your class. You will not be permitted to wait inside the school. NO DROP OFFS. Orange dots will be placed outside of the school on the side walk 2 meters apart. Students can wait here or in their vehicles until they are invited to enter for their class.
- 9.) In the first stages of reopening we are asking all parents not to come into the school. Please wait in the parking lot or once your child is in the school you can go for a drive.
- 10.) Again in the first stages of reopening we would like to ask that all students not bring water bottles or snacks of any types.

Please note that these steps are required by the Fraser health authority and are in place so that we can get up and running and back to normal as quick as possible. If we all work together we can make this a fun safe place to be.

Also note in the very rare case that someone does get sick we will immediately move to isolate and contact everyone involved. We will implement ever precautions and we will contact the health authority immediately for assistance and guidance.
